Tree/site: Tree has a robust crown that is fairly consistent around the whole tree. The top has broken off

some time ago. This tree is in the proposed Rosebud Mountain Reserve (for more information see

http://savingrosebud.com/).

Access: Drive south on Blackwater Rd. from Prince George for 45 minutes and make a right on Punchaw

Rd. at approximately 24 km past Baldy Hughes. Drive down Punchaw Rd. for 6 km. You will wo be near the top of a high area, locally called Rosebud Mountain. Just before the road takes a sharp hook to the right and enters a thick, old-growth forest, look at the tree tops to your left. You will be able to see this tree at the edge of the forest on the southwest edge of the clearing with a twisted,

old top. It is approximately 300 m from the road.
